Dog Sledding

Base Camp Bigfork dogsled trips are not a dogsled ride. Our participants need to have an eager desire to learn to mush and interact with our dogs.

HALF-DAY DOGSLEDDING

2 or 4 Participants; Age Limit: 10 years old and up; \$275/person

This option is perfect for learning the basics of dogsledding, tour of the dog yard, harness and even mush your own team of Inuit dogs on a variety of terrain. 2.5-3 hours in length.

FULL-DAY DOGSLEDDING

2 or 4 Participants; Age Limit: 10 years old and up; \$375/person

A full day of everything dogsledding. All that the half day adventure includes but more time out with your team. Full day adventures allow for getting further into the back-country and accessing a variety of epic locations to launch your trip from. A hearty fire side trail lunch is included.

OVERNIGHT WINTER CAMPING BY DOG TEAM

2-4 Participants; \$695/person; Age Limit: 12 years old and up.

Dog Sled Adventures; Olney, MT

Dog Sled Adventures is located 20 miles north of Whitefish, Montana off US highway 93 North. Specific directions will be given at time of reservations.

Dog Sledding

Rides are arranged by reservation only. Tours go out 7 days a week at 10:00, 1:00, and 3:30. They operate from the beginning of December through the end of March, snow conditions permitting. The trail is 12 miles long and runs through the foothills of the Whitefish Range in the Stillwater State Forest. Each tour lasts about an hour and a half, depending on trail conditions. 8 to 12 dogs pull each sled. Each sled comfortably fits 2 adults or a combination of adults and kids. Our larger sled will hold 3 small adults or a family of 4 (2 average-sized adults and 2 small kids). You will be seated on cushions and wrapped in a warm fur while your dogs and guide take you on an unforgettable experience. We can accommodate groups of any size. We cater to all ages and

disabilities. Please dress appropriately for winter conditions. We recommend a warm coat, hat, boots, and goggles. Ski outfits will work.

Ice Climbing

Ice climbing is the activity of ascending inclined ice formations. Usually, ice climbing refers to roped and protected climbing of features such as ice falls, frozen waterfalls, and cliffs and rock slabs covered with ice refrozen from flows of water.

Locations

Serenity Falls; A frozen waterfall in a beautiful canyon. This waterfall has two tiers, one is 20 feet tall and the other 60 feet. This is a Full Day climb option. With a short 15 minute hike in, we will gear up and work on basic ice climbing skills on the 20 ft. falls before rappelling and climbing the 60 ft. waterfall. Bring a lunch and a 30-40L backpack for this unique climbing experience. Near Marion, MT

Stone Hill; This full day option has beautiful scenery and longer climbs, 40-90 feet!

Directions; After passing through Eureka, turn Left onto Hwy 37 just after the gas station. Stay on Hwy 37 for 16.5 miles. You will pass the Koocanusa bridge and continue 2 miles until you start to see large ice formations on the roadside cliffs.

Bad Rock Canyon; Half Day Ice Climbers will meet here. Just a two minute walk up the hill, you will be at the base of these 30-40 foot tall ice climbs.

Directions; After leaving Columbia Falls heading East on Hwy 2, 1/2 mile past the Montana House of Mystery, there will be a large pullout on the right. This is our meeting spot. If you end up in Hungry Horse you've gone too far.

Backcountry skiing

Our guided backcountry ski and splitboard tours are for experienced skiers looking to safely venture out of bounds. We will be skiing out of the resort area boundary at Whitefish Mtn Resort using ski lifts for access. Skiers and riders are expected to bring their own touring gear and the knowledge to use it. A Whitefish Mountain Resort lift ticket or season pass is required. Full and Half days available.
